

Confession to Resurrection

ISAIAH 53 ⁵ But he was pierced for our transgressions,

he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.

In LUKE 15 The PRODIGAL SON: came home with a heart of humility, confession, repentance "I have sinned against heaven and against you." The Father threw his arms around his son, and threw a party.






How To Dye Easter Eggs with Whipped Cream

- Soak your hard boiled eggs in vinegar for 5-10 minutes. The vinegar is essential in helping the colors adhere to the shell You can skip this step but your colors will be muted.
- 2. Dry your eggs and set aside.
- Spread the whipped cream whipped topping or Cool whi in the wells of a muffin tin.
- Using gel food color, drop dots of your favorite colors o top of the whipped cream.
- 5. Swirl the colors slightly with knife or toothpick
- Roll the eggs around in the whipped cream and let them stand for 5-10 minutes.
- 7. Wipe dry with a paper towel DO NOT RINSE under water of the dye needs more time to set.
- 8. Enjoy!!!!!!




